### HOW TO SUBSCRIBE

The Scandinavian Journal of Information Systems is published once a year from Volume 10.

As from 1998 the journal is administrated by the IRIS Association. All subscribing as individuals will receive separate notification on how to continue subscription as members of the IRIS Association. ### HOW TO SUBMIT A PAPER

Papers may be submitted directly to any of the editors. For addresses see Web pages: <http://iris.informatics.gu.se/sjis>

A description of the scope of this journal is provided in the front of this issue. If you are in doubt whether you should send a paper to the journal don't hesitate to contact one of the editors to discuss the scope, procedures, the paper, etc.

Once the paper is submitted one of the four editors will be assigned to it, and you will be notified that we have received the paper and who the editor is. The paper will be sent to three reviewers. The journal use reviewers from Scandinavia and from the international research fields. An effort is made to find reviewers that are knowledgeable, are researchers of high esteem, and are inclined to produce review reports that are useful to the author(s).

After the review the editors will arrive at a decision whether to publish the paper or not or under which conditions the paper may later be published.

This whole process may take considerable time; but it is the policy of the journal that authors should be notified of acceptance with three months.
